

- Random intercept methodology at ACSD Annual Conference
  - 287 attendees randomly approached to complete survey
  - Interviewers used notepad laptops for data collection and online reporting
  - Interviews were conducted March 6 and 7
- Poll sponsored by CompassLearning
- Survey conducted by PURSUIT, firm out of Austin, TX
- Results carry +/- 5.7% error at 95% confidence interval






## Districts Not Prepared for Digital Age



How prepared do you believe your school(s) and/or district are when it comes to adapting the classroom to student needs in the digital age?


## Regional Differences in Attitudes

How prepared do you believe your school(s) and/or district are when it comes to adapting the classroom to student needs in the digital age?


## E-Learning Classroom Time by 2015



Thinking 5 years into the future, how much time in the classroom do you believe will be dedicated to interactive or e-learning methods and tools?



#### **E-Learning Time In Class**





#### Integration of E-Learning




How important do you believe it is that educators today more fully integrate technology like computers, iPods/iPads/iTouches, mobile phones, etc. into the classroom?

#### Tech Among Top Conference Topics




Which of the following Critical Transformations conference session topics are the most important to you? Pick three from the following list that represent the most important topics you are here to learn about.?




How important do you believe it is that educators make interactive educational technology available to students outside the classroom—like from home?
